Who is the data controller?

The data controller who makes essential decisions regarding your personal data, in particular the one who determines its purposes and means. With regard to the data processing on the positiveadamsky.hu website (hereinafter: Website), only Positive by Hinora Group Kft. (hereinafter Organization or Company) is the data controller in all cases.

What is personal data?

Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. In determining the identity of a natural person, account should be taken of all reasonable grounds that the controller may use to identify, directly or indirectly, that natural person.

Cookies are alphanumeric information packets sent by the web server with variable content, which are recorded on the user's computer and stored for a predetermined period of validity.

For what purpose is personal data processed on the Website?

When visiting the Website and using the services and functions available on the Website, data is processed by our Company in order to achieve the following purposes:

- replying to messages sent directly to e-mail addresses published on the website,
- fulfillment of requests for quotations sent using the request for quotation menu item,
- processing of personal data sent by newsletter subscribers on the Inspiring Minutes (<https://positiveadamsky.hu/hirlevel-feliratkozás>) site for direct and indirect sales

purposes. It has its own Privacy Policy:

- processing personal data sent by applicants for job applications and traineeships advertised on the site (form on <http://positiveadamsky.hu/karrier> or direct e-mail to karrier@positive.hu) in order to expand the workforce, as well as to maintain contact with job applicants and provide them with information about the reopening of the job application and other applications favourable to the applicant,
- managing cookies to ensure the operation of the Website, to serve its visitors at a higher level, to compile visitor statistics and to support our marketing activities.

What is the legal basis for data processing?

With regard to the data processing purposes specified in this Privacy Policy, the legal basis for data processing, your informed and voluntary consent to the processing of your personal data. Consent is given either by providing personal data as an active action (sending an e-mail message), or by accepting this information and ticking the check-box confirming consent, or by clicking on the "Accept" button after customizing the ticks ("off", "on") of the window that pops up for setting web cookies, or by any other active action.

With regard to web cookies that do not require consent, the legal basis for data processing is the provision of Section 13/A (3) of Act CVIII of 2001 on Certain Issues of Electronic Commerce Services and Information Society Services (Elkertv.), according to which the web service provider may process personal data that are technically indispensable for the provision of the service for the purpose of providing the service.

How can I withdraw my consent?

You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time without giving reasons. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

How can I give or withdraw my consent to web cookies?

You, as the data subject, give your voluntary consent by actively acting by clicking on the "I ACCEPT" button when the short information window about cookie use pops up. When you visit the website for the first time, you will see a so-called "cookie window" where you can see the cookies used on our website grouped.

Through the "cookie window" that appears, you can give your voluntary consent to the use of cookies for statistical and marketing purposes separately by switching the switches next to the cookies to the "ON" position.

You can change your settings – and withdraw your consent in this context – at any time on the website under the menu item "Change cookies" by switching the switches next to the cookies to the "OFF" position. In addition, you can delete all cookies used by the website at once by clicking on the "Delete cookies" menu item. Please note that when using the "Delete cookies" menu item, the "Essential basics" cookies are reinstalled on the website/device after deletion, as they are strictly necessary for the operation of the website.

How long do we process your personal data?

Personal data shall be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed.

Taking into account this principle of storage limitation, our Company enforces the following data deletion requirements:

- Messages sent directly or using the Contact menu item to e-mail addresses published on the website, as well as requests for quotations sent using the request for quotation menu item, are kept for 1 year.
- Our Company retains all personal data related to the job application until the advertised position is filled or for 6 months from the date of receipt. Your personal data will be deleted following this or your objection to the 6-month retention. The purpose of the retention period of six months after filling the advertised position is to notify you of the reopening of the job application during this period and of any further job applications favorable to you.
- If you accept cookies, they will be stored on your computer for 30 days, unless you delete them earlier. An exception to this is the so-called Session cookies, which are managed until the end of the visitor's session, so most often until the site is left.

To whom do we transfer your personal data?

In the course of processing your personal data, we use the services of Sybell Informatika Kft. (H -1158 Budapest, Késmárk u. 7/b 2. em. 206.) as data processor for IT system operation and server hosting services.

What web cookies do we use?

(1) 'essential funds' cookies:

These are cookies that are strictly necessary for the operation of the website. They are strictly necessary for the technical functioning of our website, help to make it easy to use, for example to store site navigation, user preferences or preferences, therefore it is not

possible to deactivate them, but these cookies do not collect any information that qualifies as personal data. It is not necessary to obtain your consent for the management of these cookies, but we have to provide sufficient information about their use.

2. 'statistics' cookies:

These cookies collect data through an anonymous identifier, so they do not store personal data. These cookies help us analyze website performance and improve our website. They provide us with information about the number of users, the number of pages downloaded and the device with which the visit took place (mobile, desktop, tablet, operating system type), the frequency of the visit without clearly identifying the users.

The purpose of cookies is also to understand the user's use of the website (e.g. pages viewed, navigation, session time) in order to further develop the website according to the needs of our visitors and to provide a high-quality, user-friendly experience.

(3) 'marketing' cookies:

These cookies provided by third-party providers are used to display advertisements on websites that are more relevant or of interest to you. These cookies also cannot identify you personally, they can collect information such as what page the visitor viewed, which part of the website the user clicked on, how many pages he visited, all in order to get to know the content of interest to you.

Please note that when using this website, 3rd party web cookies may also be installed to share content on social networks, to compile traffic statistics or to support our marketing activities.

What is Google Analytics?

In connection with the website of the Organization, it uses the services of the Google Analytics system. Google Analytics is Google's analytics tool that helps you get a better picture of the activities of your website visitors (including your activities) and website performance without identifying visitors individually.

The primary purpose of the data collected by the Google Analytics cookie and their use is to enable the Organization to operate its website properly, which requires, in particular, tracking website visit data (e.g. number of visits, device usage). In addition, the Organization may use this information to analyze usage trends and to improve and develop the functionality of its website and to analyze the performance of the website.

Because Google Analytics comes from a third-party 3rd party provider (Google Inc.), the information it collects (including data from your activity on the website) may be used by Google, for example, to show more relevant ads across the web on Google services (such as Google Search) and to measure interactions with ads served by Google. Google may also transfer this data to third parties that Google uses to process the data.

You can exercise a higher level of control over web cookies by making settings (blocking, revoking) in your own browser. All modern browsers allow you to change your cookie settings. Most browsers automatically accept cookies by default, but it is now possible to block third-party cookies, limit retention periods, generally block and define exceptions.

What are my rights in relation to data processing?

Pursuant to the law, you always have the right to request access, rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of your data, to object to the processing of personal data and to receive the data in portable form. You also have the right to object to the use of your personal data for direct marketing purposes, including profiling.

You may submit your request related to the processing of your personal data to our company verbally (in person) or in writing (personally or by means of a document handed over by someone else, or by post, fax or electronic mail address) at the following contact addresses:

We will evaluate your request for the enforcement of your entitlements within the shortest possible time, but not later than 25 days from the submission of it, and we will notify you of our decision in writing or, if you submitted the request electronically, electronically!

The prospectus refrains from repeating legislation in full and textually, in line with supervisory recommendations. The detailed rules are laid down in Chapter III of the GDPR entitled "Rights of data subjects" and in the Privacy Act. Contains.

Who can I contact with my questions or complaints related to data processing?

The Organization accepts questions and complaints related to data protection at the central contact details.

You have the right to initiate an investigation by a supervisory authority if you believe that the enforcement of your rights in relation to your personal data is restricted by our Company or your request to enforce these rights is rejected by our Company or you consider at any time that there has been an infringement or an imminent threat thereof in connection with the processing of your personal data.

In addition, you have the right to a judicial remedy at any time against a legally binding decision of a supervisory authority concerning you or if the competent supervisory authority does not handle the complaint or does not inform it of the progress or outcome of the complaint lodged within three months.

You may also turn to court if you consider that our Company or the data processor entrusted by it or acting on its behalf processes your personal data in violation of the requirements for the processing of personal data specified by law or a binding act of the European Union. You may also bring the action before the court competent for your domicile or residence, if you choose.
